A NOTE ABOUT BALLET IDAHO'S PRODUCTION OF THE NUTCRACKER

In many of the parts students will be onstage with the Company dancing at the same time. It is very important that students take their participation in *The Nutcracker* very seriously, understand that they are team players and remain 100% committed throughout the entire production process. With 100% commitment we can assure you that it'll be a truly rewarding experience for all!

Please	read and initial:
•	A non-refundable audition fee of \$25 is due at time of registration.
•	A non-refundable production/participation fee of \$45.00 is due once student is cast to
	cover rehearsal assistants, costume maintenance and other production fees.
•	All casting decisions are made by the artistic staff.
•	There will be ONE CAST for each part (excluding mini-mice) so most casts will be in
	each performance. There will be minimal multiple casting.
•	Nutritious food will be provided for ALL cast members the Saturday and Sunday of
	production weekend.
•	Generally, rehearsals take place on Friday evenings and Saturdays. The extent of
	rehearsals depends on the number of parts in which student is cast. In the two weeks prior
	to production, weekday afternoon rehearsals will be called with the Company. Student
	must commit to ALL rehearsals called for specific part(s).
•	Student must be available for ALL performances and ALL technical rehearsals in the
	theatre for which he/she is called. See dates below!
•	Rehearsals are mandatory; missing a rehearsal, except for illness, may result in the
	part being re-assigned. Absences MUST be reported by phone or email prior to rehearsal.
•	Students must conduct themselves in the most professional manner throughout the
	production process by being respectful to directors, instructors, fellow cast members and

volunteers. Students should review material and corrections so that they come to the next
